Project aims and learning structure

STITCH - Sustainable and Nature based Tourism IT Course and Handbook - seeks to strengthen the position of sustainable tourism concepts and subject matter within the European educational landscape. To achieve this a modular IT-based course is being developed, which can be studied at three different levels:

- Vocational and Educational Training (VET - EQR²-Level 4)
- Bachelor (EQR-Level 6)
- Masters (EQR-Level 7)

Bachelor: 180 ECTS Credits

Masters: 120 ECTS Credits

Course content

The content of the STITCH course has been broken down into six modules, which are weighted and applied differently to each of the three levels:

M2: Food and Drink Tourism
(12 ECVET)

M3: Tourism and Protected Areas
(3 ECVET)

M4: Sustainable Tourism Practice (6 ECVET)

M5: Intercultural Interferences - Problems, Causes and Solutions (3 ECVET)

M6: Technical and Pedagogical Introduction (6 ECVET)

M1: Operations of Sustainable Tourism (50 ECTS)

M2: Cultural Tourism (30 ECTS)

M3: Tourism and Protected Areas (30 ECTS)

M4: Sustainable Tourism: Policy and Planning (30 ECTS)

M5: Intercultural Interferences: Key Concepts and Interdependencies

M6: Technical and Pedagogical Introduction (6+4 ECTS)

Course content: "Masters"

M1: Strategic Sustainable Tourism Planning (20 ECTS)

M2: Heritage Tourism (22 ECTS)
M3: Tourism and Protected Areas
(22 ECTS)

M4: Strategic Sustainable Tourism Management (24 ECTS)

M5: Intercultural Interferences - Bilateral Influences between Sustainable Tourism and Culture (24 ECTS)

M6: Technical and Pedagogical Introduction (4+4 ECTS)

This modular structure as well as the accreditation concept allows students, in the run-up to taking the course, to have prior knowledge or skills certified, whether formally or informally acquired, and for which they can be receive credits. Through this the length of the training and the cost can be drastically reduced without affecting the quality of the results achieved.

Next project steps

At present the partners are occupied with pedagogical and didactic development work. The individual course units will then be fed into a learning platform, the software for which, called RUBY, has been created specifically for this project by the German partner rapidrabbit.

The development of the course content must be completed by October 2011 at the latest and then the STITCH course will be tested and evaluated at all of the different levels in the pilot phase over a number of months, before the final version of the course materials can be published in all of the languages within the partnership.
